Instructions for Club/Ministry of the year Award and Recognitions

- 1. Every club shall be governed by the rules and regulations established by the AY Department of the Gulf States Conference and the Camp Alamisco Directives. **No unregistered club members will be aloud**.
- 2. Participation can be established with two members.
- 3. Each club must proof a minimum of one meeting per month and at least 8 of outreach visit for 2022-2023 Year. (Outreach is ones a month with the MG club or any other club). Please look at the reporting forms PDF or electronic reporting on MG Web Site.
- 4. All staff and staff over 18 years of age must have proof of the Sterling Volunteers Training and background check and CPR certification (for Invested MG's) before coming to camp. If you do not have the CPR updated, please contact your area coordinator to register for the class in February (Evidence will be evaluated).
- 5. Evidence of Work Plan for the year, 2022-2023 must be evidenced with Church Board Signature. (Area Coordinator should have received a copy)
- 6. All campers should have their Class A and B uniform. (New club Exceptions should be communicated on time before Club Inspection at camp).
- 7. It is a MUST HAVE **Travel insurance for this event** and activities, especially Camporee 2023. Official documents will be requested at arrival at locating or at camp inspection.
- 8. All under 18 years old must have the consent form singed by parents or legal guardian in front of the club director, or church Pastor. Medical Consent should address who is in charge of decision making in an adverse event or emergency situation arises.
- 9. Every club Director will have a **Row Call Card**, which should be given at check in. This card should be turned in before the last event on Sunday, 8:00 AM.

10. Every Camp Site MUST be always clean. Trash thrown away before bedtime. NO EATING in tents is allowed. After you are dismissed, we expect that your area has been "Ant Operation Efficient." YOUR CLUB will receive a **BILL of \$50.00** if trash is found in your assigned area.

Camp-Cleaning Assignments

All Clubs- will receive at Directors meeting, a camp site area for cleaning and garbage disposal after Camporee is dismissed. Please be aware of this and communicate to club members.

Best Camping Club -Point System Table (Row Call Table). Look for table in the registration Package or ask your area Coordinator for details. You must get a Council Member or Coordinator to Sign the form at **each row call event**. (You could designate a time keeper).

Investiture Requirements and Evaluation Forms.

If you are planning to get invested or any member of your club is planning to do so, Directors, please see Master Guide Website for PDF Download for the **Investiture Request Form**. The Club Director will be sending the authorized request to the Youth Department no later than **March 30**th, (this will give the Youth Department to order the Investiture Material on time) with required payment and for further approval by Area Coordinator or Youth Director. Candidates that the Area Coordinator has not evaluated will **not** get invested at camporee unless a previous arrangement has been made with Master Guide Coordinator.
